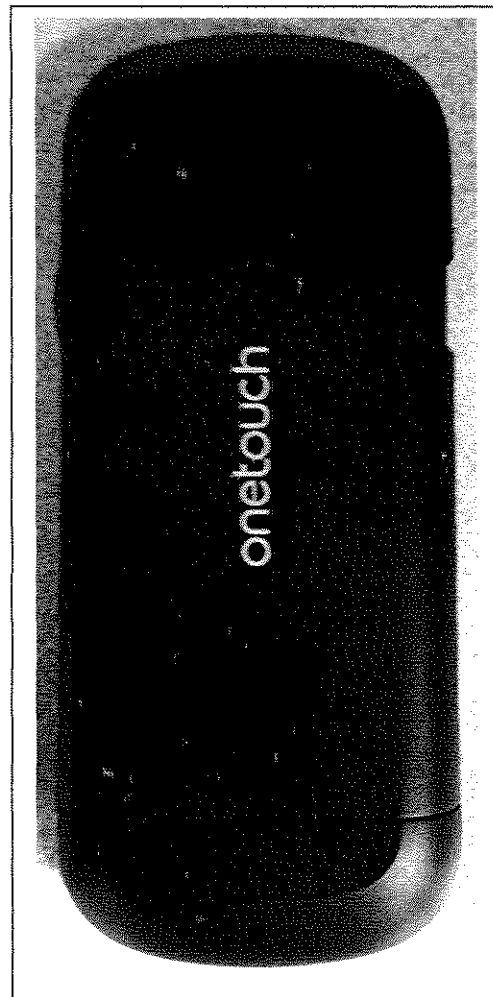
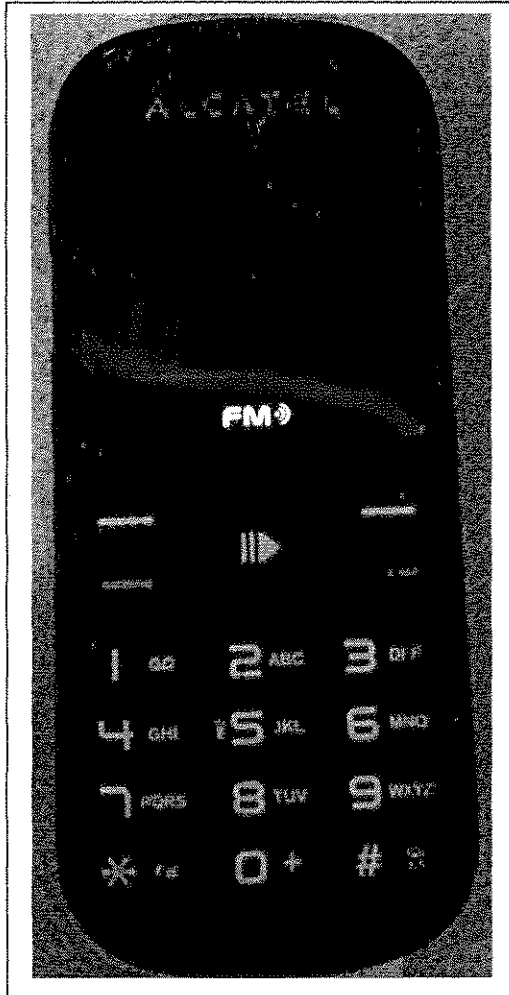

## **2 Getting started.....**

### **2.1 Set-up**

Remove the back and battery and place the SIM card with the chip facing downwards and slide it into its housing. Make sure that it is correctly inserted. To remove the card, press it and slide it out. Then place the battery on with prongs facing down as instructed on the battery. Place the back on.

### **2.2 Power on your phone**

Hold down the red key until the phone powers on.

### **2.3 Power off your phone**

Hold down the red key from the home screen.

## **3 Calls.....**

### **3.1 Making a call**

Dial the desired number then press the green key to place the call. If you make a mistake, you can delete the incorrect digits by pressing the clear key.

To hang up the call, press the red key.

### **Making an emergency call**

If your phone is covered by the network, dial emergency number and press the green key to make an emergency call. This works even without a SIM card and without typing the PIN code or unlocking the keypad.

### **3.2 Calling your voicemail (1)**

To access your voicemail, hold down the key.

### **3.3 Receiving a call**

When you receive an incoming call, press the green key to talk and then hang up using the red key.

### **3.4 Available functions during the call**

During a call, you can use your directory, short messages, etc. without losing your correspondent.

## **4 Call log**

Shows the calls you have made and received.

## **5 CONTACTS.....**

To access the contacts from the idle screen, press the menu key on the home page and select the book icon from the menu.

### **Adding a contact**

Select **Options**” then select **“Add contact”** then choose to save to your Sim or handset. Enter name and number then save.

## **6 Messages.....**

### **6.1 Create SMS**

From the main menu select **“Messages”** to create text message. You can type a message, and you're also able to insert a pre-defined message from **“Templates”**. While writing a message, select **“Options”** to access all the messaging options. You can save your messages that you send often to **“Drafts”**.

## **7 Settings.....**

From the main menu, select the menu icon and select the Function of your choice in order to customize your telephone: Display, Clock, Keys, Power saving (1), Dictionary, More settings...

## **8 Tools and Games....**

### **Games**

Your Alcatel phone includes some games. Select **“Game settings”**, it allows you to manage settings, in which you may set background audio and vibration alert.

### **8.2 Organizer**

Once you enter this menu, there is a monthly-view calendar for you to Keep track of important appointments, etc. Days with events entered will be marked.

### **8.3 Voice memo**

This allows you to record. To do so press options new record then save when you're done.

### **8.4 Alarm**

Your mobile phone has a built-in alarm clock with snooze feature.

## **8.5 Calculator**

Hold down the # key to get the decimal point. Confirm with the pressing ok.

## **8.6 File manager**

Shows you how much memory is available on your handset

## **8.7 Torch**

To light in darkness, you may activate “**Torch**” by below operations:

In home screen, hold down button number 5. You should able to use your flashlight then hold down 5 again to turn it off.

## **9 Games.....**

Your Alcatel phone may include some games.

### **9.1 Game settings**

It allows you to manage settings, in which you may set background audio and vibration alert.

## **10FM Radio.....**

Your phone is equipped with an FM radio (3) with RDS functionality. You can use the application as a traditional FM radio with automatic tuning and saved channels or with parallel visual information related to the radio program on the display, if you tune to stations that offer Visual Radio service. You can listen to it while running other applications

## **11Profiles.....**

With this option, you may personalize ringtones for different events and environments. Profiles are located in settings..

## **12Services.....**

Contact your network operator to check service availability.
